# What We Can and Cannot Do - Our Support Services Explained (Scope of Practice Guide)

The Iris Project Inc. provides **non-medical** support services.

This means we help with day-to-day activities, but we **cannot** perform any medical or nursing tasks.

Here's a simple guide to what our Support Workers can and cannot do.



## **Daily Living**

- · Light housekeeping
- Laundry
- Meal preparation
- Help with eating (non-medical)
- Staying hydrated
- Organizing the home

### **Personal Support (Non-Medical)**

- Bathing or showering
- Getting dressed
- Hygiene and grooming
- Changing briefs
- Bathroom support (non-medical)

# **Mobility & Safety**

- Walking support
- Stand-by help
- Getting in/out of chairs and beds
- · Safety awareness



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### **Community Support**

- Going out into the community
- Appointments
- Shopping
- Social and recreational outings
- Companionship

# **Memory & Routine Support**

- · Cueing and reminders
- Redirecting
- Helping with routines
- Emotional reassurance

## Medication — Limited Support

#### We can:

- √ Give verbal reminders
- √ Hand you your pharmacy-prepared blister pack/medication roll
- √ Open the package if needed

#### We cannot:

- X Give injections
- X Choose or sort pills
- X Give loose pills
- **X** Manage PRN medication
- X Crush or mix medication



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# X What We CANNOT Do (Medical Tasks)

These tasks must be done by a nurse or medical professional:

- Wound care or bandages
- Giving medications directly
- Tube feeding
- Catheter care
- Ostomy care
- Injections (including insulin)
- · Medical bath routines
- Bowel programs (suppositories, enemas, stimulation)
- Using mechanical lifts
- Monitoring or interpreting vital signs
- Following swallowing or dysphagia meal plans
